# Challenge

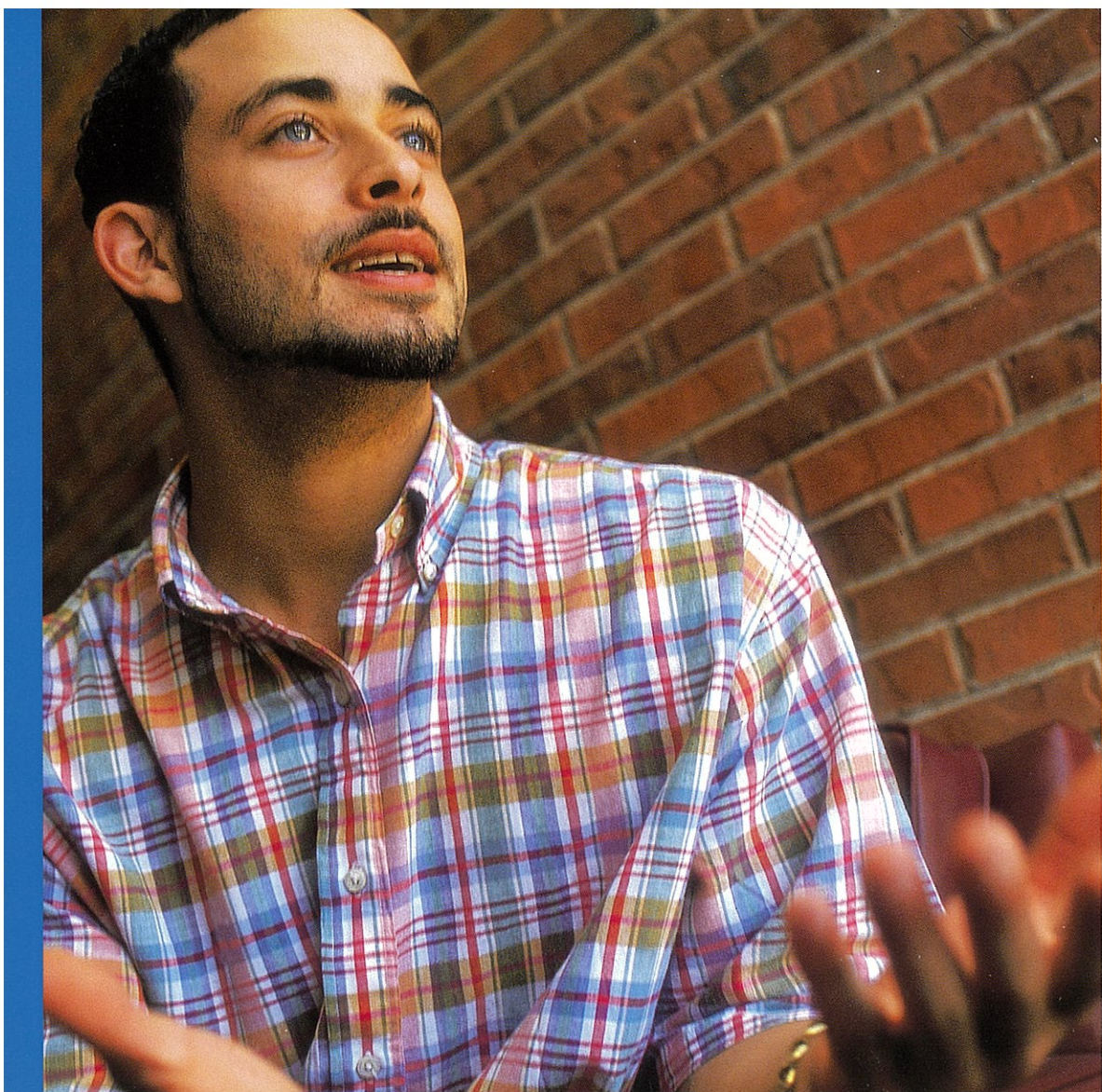
Want to learn something amazing?

Reach higher in the Honors Program at Bentley. In these courses, you'll visit Boston biotech companies to dissect the debate about privacy in genetic research. You'll get online data in the Trading Room to analyze financial markets. You'll tour the Boston Big Dig project, and investigate art forgeries at the Museum of Fine Arts. You'll have a chance to attend the Boston Symphony Orchestra. You may even study the ins and outs of the movie industry: how movies work, their status as an art form, and their impact on the values of contemporary society.

The **Honors Program** is a four-year journey that provides special challenge and fulfillment to Bentley students. Honors courses offer an extra intellectual

challenge in a seminar setting, with out-of-classroom activities such as films, theater, distinguished speakers, and trips to innovative businesses — all designed to deepen your academic experience. There are amazing discoveries at every turn.

You'll make the trip with a select group: only 10 percent of each class is invited to participate. That means an average class size of 18 students, one-on-one faculty advising, and a strong sense of community and fellowship. When you complete the program, you'll be recognized as an Honors Scholar and receive your diploma with the honors group at Commencement. Take the challenge and earn the pride that comes from reaching higher — and succeeding.

To build a career, you should master more than marketing or accounting or finance. Bentley offers 17 majors and **more than 20 minors** in both business and the arts and sciences — to ensure you get the well-rounded global education you're looking for and employers expect. A minor is a strategic asset. It brings depth and breadth to your education and allows you to explore diverse interests. For instance, combine a major in marketing with a minor in English and jump into a public relations career. Pair a major in corporate finance with study in information technology for a high-tech trading job on Wall Street. If your aspirations are worldly, complement international studies with a minor in modern languages and set your sights on a career in global business. There is almost no limit to what you can do.

Have law school in mind? Our pre-law program addresses diverse topics such as international business, real estate, environment, race and gender, securities, ethics and cyberlaw. Cyberlaw — an emerging field on the fast-changing rules of cyberspace — is a Bentley specialty. We were among the first colleges in the country to offer cyberlaw courses, and two of our professors published the first textbook on the topic for business students. Our law professors also advise students one-on-one to help with course selection and law school applications.

Joining the Bentley Consumer Action Line (BCAL) will boost your law school chances as well. Part of the college's larger service-learning movement, BCAL mediates disputes between merchants and consumers and has thus far saved consumers more than \$500,000. Funded by the Massachusetts Attorney General's Office, BCAL is the only student-run consumer office in the state. Internships in Boston and the surrounding community are another great way to fine-tune your skills and make career connections.

Ready to see things from a new perspective?

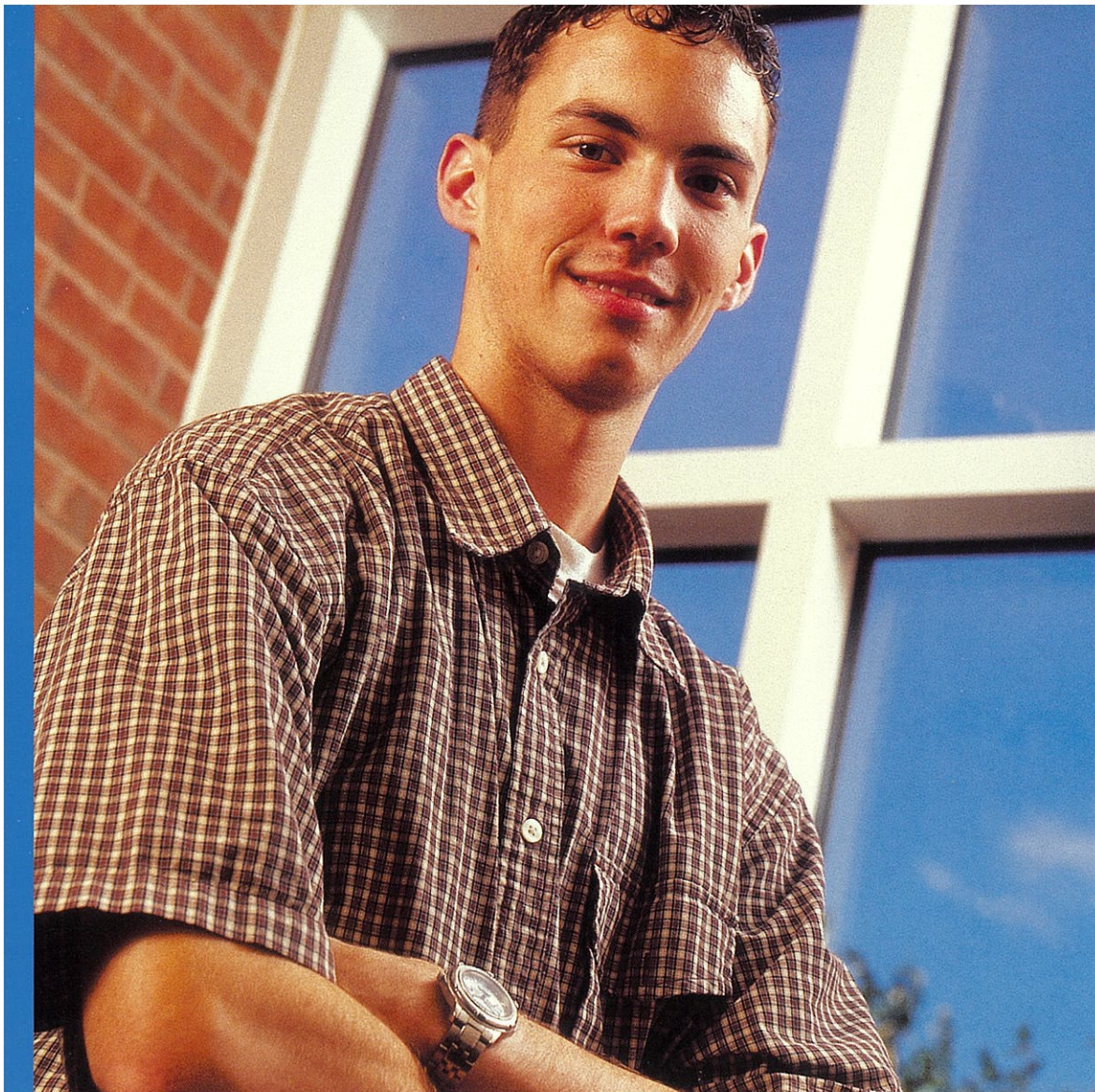
